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0 INTRODUCTION

1 THE DOMAIN

The “**orchestra-project.eu**” domain name was purchased by ODTU MEMS for 4 years (covering a certain period beyond the project) and registered on 15.09.2022. The security certificate was issued by Sectigo RSA Domain Validation Secure Server CA as of 01.10.2022.

2 STRUCTURE OF THE ORCHESTRA WEBSITE

The website provides the main point of initial contact and information to the public and to other researchers. Based on the objective of WP5 (Dissemination, exploitation, communication and outreach), the website has been designed to be clear, professional, crawlable and responsive. It is intended for publication of both general content regarding the project, but also of links to the technical nonconfidential deliverables, as soon as they become available. The website layout has been designed and the pages were created by ODTÜ MEMS using WordPress, which facilitates updating the content by the project management team. It has a clear graphic language, which is also used for all other promotional materials prepared by the project partners.

The header part (Figure 1) involves the graphical identity, menu items (about, consortium, work plan, publications, events, contact us) and links to social media pages of OrChESTRA:

2.4 “Publications” tab

The “Publications” page will provide the source of all the material of the project excluding confidential information. This page will be constantly updated with material as soon as it is produced by the project, including public deliverables, technical publications, reports, public presentations, leaflets, factsheets, press releases etc. All documents will be available Open Access.

2.5 “Events” tab

The “Events” page is intended to provide latest updates related to the activity of the project to get a quick refresh on what happened on the recent period. This page will be constantly updated with the latest content and related news/photos such as upcoming meetings, participation in events, dissemination actions, conferences, publications, etc.
